CAPE LEVEQUE PHOTOGRAPHY EXPERIENCE - 3 DAYS



Day One

Pick up from your Broome accommodation at 8.30am. We travel by 4WD on the red road to Cape Leveque with a stop at Beagle Bay for morning tea and our first shoot of the trip, the beautiful Beagle Bay church and it's pearl shell interior.

We then make our way to Cape Leveque and the award winning Kooljaman at Cape Leveque over- looking the red Pindan cliffs, white sand and the Indian Ocean.

We explore the surrounds of Kooljaman before preparing our camera gear for our sunset shoot on West Beach.

Tonight we have dinner on the Sunset Deck at Kooljaman followed by a night sky shoot.

Day Two

Landscape sunrise shots down on main beach for those early risers. Or an early morning bird photography walk through the grounds of Kooljaman. There are a variety of birds here including finches, wrens, bowerbirds, parrots and osprey and sea eagles.

This morning we will head out on our Indigenous tour to special spots only accessible with a local Aboriginal guide. Here we will have the opportunity for a range of images from landscape, wildlife and macro and even some environmental portraits of our fabulous hosts.

Our days will revolve around the sunrise and sunset, the tides and of course the time of year, so a flexible itinerary is a must in this region.

So many sunset locations, but we have to choose!

After a beautiful chef prepared dinner we can head out for our night sky shoot.



Day Three

Again we can do a sunrise shoot or a bird photography session, the choice is yours.

This morning we have the optional scenic flight to the Horizontal Falls that will take off from Kooljaman airstrip for a spectacular flight over the 1,000 island of the Buccaneer Archipelago or if you are here in the Humpback Whale migration period you may prefer a whale watching trip.

If time permits we will travel to Ardyaloon Community at One Arm Point. Here you will have the opportunity to photograph some amazing landscapes and massive tidal movements as well as visit the Ardyaloon Trochus Hatchery & Aquaculture Centre.

The adventure never stops as we drive back along the red Pindan track and into Broome by late afternoon.
